

August 6 – Ryan Mohling, "Young Life International Global Leader Program"

Ryan spoke to us about his five-year Young Life (YL) experience in Costa Rica and his new position with YL International to develop global leaders 30 countries. This program offers educational funds, life-skills mentoring, and ministry training for the leaders of tomorrow. YL leaders around the world come alongside young people who have the potential to become transformational leaders in their communities and countries. YL chooses 100 students every year from the more than 33,000 who are involved with YL internationally. The program provides chosen students with: 1) Money for a university education and some cost-of-living expenses, 2) A mentor to walk



with them through a life-skills curriculum, 3) Ministry training from Young Life staff and, 4) Leadership responsibilities to recruit, train and impact others. August 13 – Ann Elliott, CU Women's Lacrosse Coach

On 8/13 we had the privilege of having Ann Elliott, the new head coach for women's lacrosse at the University of Colorado, Boulder speak to us about the new program at the school. Ann has had great success as both a player and a coach coming to Boulder from Northwestern University. There she has been a part of 7 of the last 10 NCAA Division I women's Lacrosse National Championship teams. Lacrosse is a sport that is growing rapidly in popularity among young women. The primary difference between women's and men's lacrosse is the level of physicality in the sport. CU will join four other schools from the PAC-12 conference as they compete



beginning in 2014. Ms. Elliot grew up in Cleveland, Ohio playing ice hockey and discovered lacrosse late in her high school career. We are very excited to have her in our community as she leads a new group of young athletes. Thank you Ann for talking to us about your sport!
